

The Senior Citizen Deferral Program provides a <u>low-interest loan</u> to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes.

This is not a tax forgiveness program, however, this program:

• Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and

• Endures the amount of tax paid remains the same as long as you participate in this program.

To be eligible, you must file an application by November 1, 2024, as well as:

- Be at least 65 years old,
- Have a household income of \$96,000 or less, and
- Have lived in your home for at least 5 years. To receive a fact sheet and application for this program, or to file an on-line application, go to www.revenue.state.mn.us and type "deferral" into the search box. You may also call the Senior Deferral Administrator at (651) 556-4803 to have the information mailed to you.

Penalty for Late Payment of Property Tax

If you pay your first half or second half property tax after the due dates, a penalty will be added to your tax. The later you pay, the greater the penalty you will pay. The table below shows the penalty amounts added to your tax if your property taxes are not paid before the date shown. To avoid a penalty, envelopes must be postmarked by the due date to be considered paid on time. First half tax payments must be paid in full with penalty (if applicable) prior to applying money toward second half payment.
