SENIOR CITIZEN **PROPERTY TAX**

- The Senior Citizen Deferral Program provides a <u>low-interest loan</u> to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes. This is not a tax forgiveness program, however, this program: • Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and
- Endures the amount of tax paid remains the same as long as you participate in this program. To be eligible, you must file an application by November 1, 2024, as well as:
- 1 Be at least 65 years old,
- Deferral
- Have a household income of \$96,000 or less, and 2. 3
 - Have lived in your home for at least 5 years.

Penalty for Late Payment of Property Tax
